New Tests and Equipment

Technology upgrade is an integral part of the services offered at Chughtai Healthcare. With the advent of modern Health Technology tools, we are delivering improved services and patient-care experience to our customers across Pakistan. Here are the details on the new addition to our labs;



BD FACSLYRIC in the Haematology Department

This machine helps with the HLA CROSS MATCH testing and enables health professionals to evaluate whether or not a patient has antibodies against a certain donor. Flow DSA cross-match test is performed by using a kit of ONE LAMBDA USA.



COBAS E601 in the Chemistry Lab Diagnostic

COBAS E601 is set to change the course of diagnosis services by using a fully automated Electro Chemiluminescent immunoassays (ECLIA) methodology. These testing devices offer higher system reliability and intelligent sample workflow increasing accuracy and efficiency.



Chemistry Lab receives the new **LABSCAN 3D**

LABScan3D is the most advanced Luminex® system to date; the two syringe pumps and reagent reservoirs enable increased throughput and scheduled maintenance. This machine will drastically improve our ability to process multiple tests, enhancing efficiency and accuracy.

Fighting the Dengue Epidemic

The year 2021 tested the boundaries of our medical capacities in every way possible.

There were 48,906 dengue cases reported between January 1 and November 25, 2021, with 183 deaths and a case fatality ratio (CFR) of 0.44 percent. From September to November 2021, Pakistan faced a two-pronged threat from COVID-19 and Dengue, further adding to the challenge. Chughtai Healthcare continued to serve the patients through its lab services as the CBC registrations reached overwhelming numbers.

We were only able to achieve this mammoth of a task through the following:

- The addition of two new instruments, such as the Abbott haematology analyser.
- Increased human resources through quick hiring.
- Increased shift timings for the technical team to 12 hours.
- Inclusion of post-graduate residents in the workforce and assigning them early morning and Sunday duties.



Chughtai Lab's Rapid COVID-19 Testing at Airports

Our Venture into **Clinical** and **Forensic Toxicology**

Chughtai Healthcare is known for its medical expansion and exploration. One such example is the establishment of our Clinical and Forensic Toxicology Department.



Launched in December 2020 in Lahore under the supervision of Dr. Humera Shafi Makhdoom—a foreign-trained and certified expert in Forensic Toxicology and Drug Chemistry, this department is expected to take the Chughtai portfolio to new horizons. Equipped with the latest analytical instruments and highly skilled professionals, this state-of-the-art department revolutionises the understanding of Clinical and Forensic Toxicology in Pakistan.

Aligned to the vision of a “Drug-Free Pakistan” by Dr. Akhtar Sohail Chughtai (CEO, Chughtai Healthcare), the Department of Clinical and Forensic Toxicology will play a pivotal role in reducing and efficiently treating narcotics in Pakistan. The facility introduces the latest drug technology to test poisons, toxic gases, volatiles, metals, and steroids (DOPE test) in clinical and forensic cases.

According to a UN report, the estimated number of addicts in Pakistan is 7.6 million. The number of addicts is estimated to rise by 40,000 annually, making Pakistan one of the most adversely affected countries in the world. The department will immensely benefit schools, colleges,

universities, law enforcement agencies, civil aviation, psychology and psychiatry clinics, rehabilitation centres, and national and multinational companies.

The confirmation tests for drug abuse are conducted using state-of-the-art instruments like liquid chromatography-tandem mass spectrometry (LC-MS-MS). Currently, we are performing quantitative tests for Vitamin A and E, screening, and confirmation of drugs of abuse like cannabinoids, amphetamines, opiates, tricyclic antidepressants, benzodiazepines, phencyclidine, and cocaine. These tests include Forensic Urine testing or workplace drug testing.

Chughtai Public Library celebrates the publication of its first book


The Chughtai Public Library project's objective is to promote reading and publish engaging content that highlights unique talents such as Mehboob Ali.




Engaging Children in Community Health Drives
